Growing desire for self-sufficiency

As the products allow the conversion of excess solar electricity into hot water and space heating, the sales channels for my-PV are growing with the worldwide increasing thought of autonomy. CEO Dr. Gerhard Rimpler explains: "The feed-in of photovoltaics is becoming increasingly unprofitable with the new legislation in Belgium and the Netherlands, and self-consumption is rising. In the south of Australia, customers already pay for the feed-in, which also favors self-use. In Upper Austria, there is even a feed-in ban for new photovoltaic installations, and other



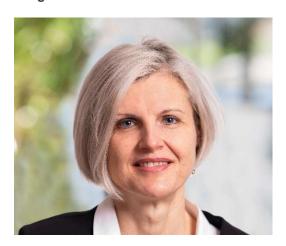
